LATEST NEWS FROM PASTOR MORLEY AND TEAM IN LONDON

Dear Friends, **“Reach the world in London”** is still our motto and we are happy to say that we had a wonderful summer reaching out in His Name in South East London. Here are just a few testimonies: Met a young girl from London who believes in re-incarnation (Buddhist) she was brought up so called Christian! Had good discussion about the necessity of the blood for forgiveness of sin! Spoke with some Iraqi women who came out of the RC Church and gave them a gospel in Arabic and a Jesus DVD! Spoke with young students from Thailand (Buddhists) and showed them the story of Nicodemus and the need to be born again, they were intrigued. Another man said he cannot believe God loves him because he took his only son, he screwed up the tract we gave him, P. Larry prayed for him as he walked away and he told me about this man. Anyway P. Larry was talking with someone else when the man came back to apologise - I spoke with him about how God can identify with him in that He gave His only son for our sin. He was so soft and said he had never seen it like that before and took another tract. God is so after people, pray they can receive! We met a lady whose son was a policeman and was killed 3 years ago it was his birthday, we encouraged her to draw near to God who comforts those who mourn and prayed with and for her. We met a precious young couple: he from Cyprus and she from Turkey, they listened to the gospel and took a gospel of John in Turkish, we pray they read it together and come to faith in Jesus as their Saviour. There was a middle aged English lady walking by and she recently attended her daughters wedding in a Church where she felt very comfortable and happy, she and I had a long, long conversation and she was very open to the Gospel, I pray she commits her life to Jesus. As we were finishing our conversation a drunk man came up behind us shouting Jesus is DEAD! And then appeared across the road where Martina had just lead a young girl to Christ shouting Jesus is DEAD! We believe such obvious demonic opposition proves God is truly at work. In Lewisham there was a man busking with a dog playing famous hymns on the saxophone, we told him how conducive this was to the message we were proclaiming! He said he came to Lewisham that day by chance! We met a young man from Syria, what a great time we had sharing the gospel with him, he took a book in Arabic called “The Messiah” we pray he reads it and discovers what Jesus accomplished for him personally on the cross. Met a Kurdish man who said ‘yes I believe in God’, ‘the Bible and the Koran are the same’, we asked him if he had ever read the Bible, no, so we offered him a gospel and a book on the Messiah in Arabic which he gladly accepted. A young mother from Philippines took a tract and stopped to read it, she was Roman Catholic but said her sister was Baptist and ‘born again.’ Coming from a similar background I shared my testimony with her. We spent the best part of an hour with a Caribbean lady who had been to Church as a young person, then a Seventh Day Adventist and now she goes nowhere but is searching the internet, we shared with her from the Bible and pray she finds Salvation through the Lord Jesus Christ. met an Iranian and a Turkish lady and gave them the Jesus DVD and a gospel in their languages. On the High Street in Catford a Turkish lady received a tract, walked along reading it and was so open to the words of Jesus. We exchanged phone numbers and she has since discovered she has cancer, we are in touch with her and praying for her. May God draw her to Himself. He has certainly come to seek and save the lost. We love Him because He first loved us!
